**Program:**

Dennis Wong, Past President of the Westport Sunrise Club, discussed the significance of the Peace Pole that he displayed. The Peace Pole, which originated in Japan, states "May Peace Prevail on Earth" in four languages. There are more than 200,000 Peace Poles displayed throughout the world, and they reflect the Rotary goals of eradicating polio, building membership, and supporting the Rotary Foundation. Dennis also discussed the Four-Way Test and how it can be used as a process to move toward ethical behavior.
