### **Program**

Buck Griswold and Ken Dartley came to speak with us about the Wilton Commons project---affordable senior housing/assisted living. The project will be on 4-5 acres for land that the town will lease to the project off of Rt 7 across from Perry Green and next to Trackside. The committee will raise \$2M and hope to receive \$19.5M in State and Federal money thru grants and tax credits. The 77 units will be one and 2 bedrooms ranging in price depending on income. Mutual Housing of SW CT will be helping with the construction and suggestions for the project. Buck seems excited about the project and that it will be an asset to Wilton and so far they have raised \$1.23M.
