Program: Bryan Mattimore, "Chief Idea Guy" - The Growth Engine Company

Need a Big Idea? It might come to you while standing ankle deep in a waterlogged pasture, with nine-iron held high, during a severe thunderstorm. Bryan offers a different path arguing that prolific creativity is more often the product of technique. Tracing the science of brainstorming and other methods to the work of Alex Osborn, the "O" in DDB&O, Bryan described techniques that in a group setting can stimulate sluggish neurons to develop valuable and creative ideas. Performed correctly, his techniques work. The waterlogged pasture thing might not. His innovation projects have led to over \$3 billion in new sales for a wide variety of Fortune 500 clients. Bryan is the author of three books on business creativity, the latest of which is <u>21 Days to a Big Idea</u>.
