Today's Program:

Our guest speaker, Dr. Ashleigh Sebro, DDS – owner of Wilton Pediatric Dentistry established June 6 2018.

The fact that this Torontonion started dreaming about becoming a dentist at just 5 years old is apparent in her fierce commitment to the industry and her countless hours of volunteer and pro bono work. In dental school, Dr. Sebro founded the Pediatric Education and Dental Outreach club, an organization that helps pay for dental services for underserved children. She has completed several domestic and international mission trips, and—a notable accomplishment in its own right—she opened her own pediatric practice at just 30 years old.

Dr. Sebro has dedicated her life to becoming a dentist who could positively impact children. She received her BSc from McGill University before completing her DDS from SUNY Buffalo. After dental school, Dr. Sebro furthered her training with an advanced education in pediatric dentistry at Temple

University Hospital. Having settled in Connecticut with her husband, Dr. Sebro is now ready to bring her positive attitude and compassionate disposition to the Wilton community.

Most recently Dr. Sebro was an honoree of Incisal Edge Magazine's 40 Under 40 list, which recognizes the top young dentists in the nation. She was nominated for her commitment to dentistry and for her dedication to charity and philanthropy.

Dr. Sebro stressed that a child's first visit to the dentist should be 12 months old vs. 5 years old in order to catch bad habits before they set in and cause future issues. Wilton Pediatric Dentistry provides a fun, comfortable atmosphere for children so that they are relaxed and enjoy their visits to the dentist. There are flat screen TVs above each dental chair. Their lobby has a Giant Gumball Machine filled with toys that can be obtained with TOKENS awarded to kids who demonstrate good behavior. Ex. One token for sitting in the dentist chair, one token for no cavities.
