Program

First Selectman Bill Brennan spoke about the town's effort to raise money for the planned Veterans Memorial Green commemorating the men and women from Wilton who have fallen in service to our country.

This is a \$65,000 project which will be dedicated on Veteran's Day, November 11, 2010. Six granite monuments will be inscribed with the names of Wilton's honored war dead from the French & Indian War through the conflict in Iraq and Afghanistan. The Memorial will be located at the intersection of Center Street and Old Ridgefield Road. In addition to the granite columns, it will include a landscaped bluestone plaza with benches and a lighted flagpole.

The Town of Wilton has contributed the land and site preparation work, and the Memorial Committee is seeking donations from community organizations, school children, town clubs, churches, businesses and citizens.
