Today's Program

Wilton Fire Marshall David Kohn and Wilton Fire Inspector Rocco Grasso spoke to us about summer fire safety, especially in handling and use of the fuel tank for propane grills:

- Use great care in handling and transporting tanks;
- Do not store indoors;
- Frequently check condition of fittings and hoses, especially at the beginning of the season;
- Do not cook indoors (even in the garage with the door open!);
- Refill only at authorized propane tank refilling stations – do not overfill;
- Do not use a grill very close to the house;
- Have a fire extinguisher handy!
