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Fourteen Wilton Rotarians Banged the Gong for the millionth meal packaged locally and distributed by Rise Against Hunger, formerly Stop Hunger Now!



A million meals distributed around the world to those in need have been produced through the local Rise Against Hunger program coordinated by the Wilton Interfaith Action Committee (WI-ACT). The Rise Against Hunger program has been supported by the community, in particular, the Wilton Rotary Club. For the last eight years the Wilton volunteers have packaged 150,000, or so, meals annually, enough to feed 450 children each year. Once packaged, the meals are distributed by Rise Against Hunger to places in desperate need. In the past the meals have been distributed to Haiti, sub-Saharan Africa, the Philippines, and Central America. For more information see: www.riseagainsthunger.org/.
